

Instruction Sheet for Video Lectures

1. Start a new page in your notebook titled, "**Lecture Notes for Lesson __**".
2. Do not read the textbook pages before or during the lecture.
3. Take **brief** notes on headings, formulas, key points, and solving example problems.
4. **The most important part of the lecture:** After each example problem is taught in the lecture, pause the lecture and try to solve the example problem on paper. Rewind and fast-forward as needed until you understand.
5. Don't simply copy the example problems. Try to solve them on your own. This will develop understanding and make it easier to solve the problems in the Practice Set (homework).

I DON'T UNDERSTAND THE LECTURE

1. Open the link to the "Lesson Reference Chart", linked below the link to the lecture.
2. Follow the steps at the top of the chart. If needed, watch the lecture again.
3. Even if you don't fully understand the lecture, go ahead and do all the problems you can in the Practice Set. Follow all the steps on the Instruction Sheet for Practice Sets (linked above each Practice Set) including using the help links, all the way through watching the video solutions and solving missed problems on paper. Usually, after following this process you will understand the lecture.
