There are 2 lessons ( $78 \& 103$ ) in the Algebra $1,2^{\text {nd }}$ edition, that are not covered in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ edition. Understanding all of the CD-ROM lessons cross referenced to lesson 113 is not critical to your success in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ edition, but it is important that you try to understand them all. Also, there are three lessons in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ edition that are not covered in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ edition., and you should watch these lessons as well.
